**Attendance:** Children should not be left unattended at rehearsal sessions unless aged 10+. Children wishing to participate in the show must attend ALL rehearsals.

**Rehearsals:** Absolutely no admittance to parents during rehearsals. Some of the older children are welcome to stay and watch (if they are quiet!) as they will also be helping me with the younger children.

**Punctuality:** Please arrive *15 minutes* before rehearsal time slots and *30 minutes* before each performance.

**Backstage helpers:** The show cannot take place without all parents offering to help with at least one show. Moya will be recruiting parents after the Easter holiday, so please sign up. Thank you, your children need your support.

**Make-up:** Girls should wear appropriate make-up for all rehearsals and shows unless children have allergies to it. Red lipstick and brown or blue eye shadow.

**Hair:** All girls in ballet must have hair in a bun. Girls in tap and street dance only require hair in a pony tail.

**Shoes:** Girls ballet pink satin, boys ballet black leather, white rabbit white ballet shoes.

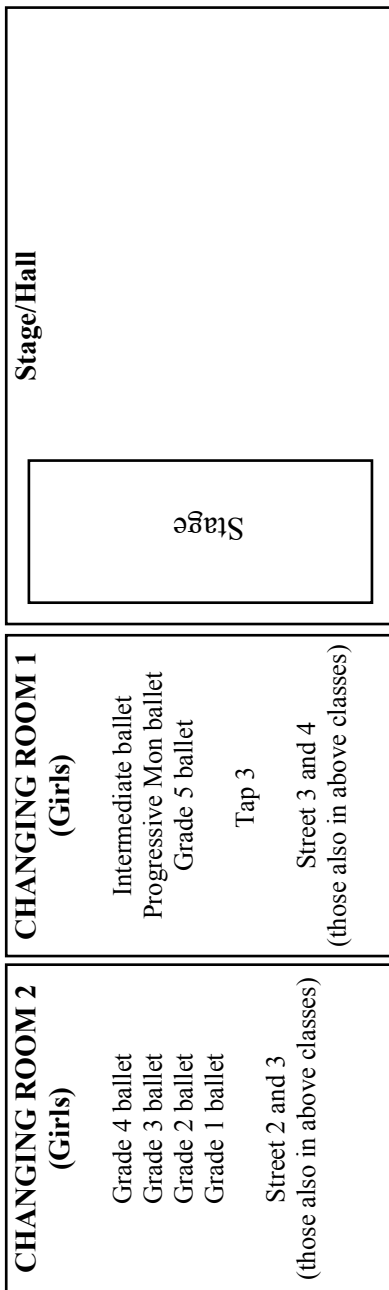

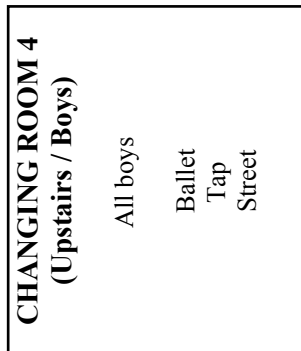
