Ballet Exams

- The exams are now very close. Please check your exam packs for details.
- Anyone who has not yet paid their exam fees please do so asap.
- Remember that ISTD Grade 4 ballet is the equivalent of a GCSE pass.
- High standards of grooming and time keeping are imperative when it comes to ballet exams.
- Please do not hesitate to direct any exam queries to Rebecca or Anne.
- All the children are amazing and have worked very hard to get to the standard required. We are here to support them and you.
- All students need to be presented for their exam in pristine uniform as detailed below:
 - Good condition leotard with matching belt Clean satin ballet shoes for girls with elastic for grade 1 and ribbon for grades 3 & 4 New ballet tights Hair in a ballet bun No underwear showing – exam underwear is available to purchase
- If you need help with the ballet bun Sarah will be available but please allow at least 45 minutes spare before your time slot if you wish to avail yourself of this service. All students need to be ready 30 minutes before their actual ballet exam time.
- Anne is available on the exam lesson day 4th January as well as the first two Saturdays of the term 11th & 18th January. She will also be at the mocks and exams with emergency tights, shoes, belts, hair accessories etc.

Show 2020

- Although July may seem a long time away, the preparation and organisation for the 25th anniversary event started a few months ago. Please book these dates in your diary as choreography will be starting this term.
- If your child is unable to participate it is very important that you let us know as soon as possible. Lessons will still enhance their dance training.
