Following the latest government guidelines the Liphook Academy of Dance will close its doors with immediate effect due to the covid-19 pandemic. Legally all dance studios must close. If the government schedule goes to plan we shall be able to resume classes on Thursday 3rd December.

The free trials for the new Primary classes for 4-5 year olds will thus be on Saturday 12th December. This is assuming that guidelines and circumstances do not change again.

Lessons will now be available via Zoom. This worked very well during the last lockdown. In order to access lessons for ballet grades 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 and progressive you will be sent links via email. Please ensure you register the day before and pay via the paypal link weekly. This is a pay as you go service. Lessons are 30 minutes for ballet grades @ £5 and 45 minutes for progressive @ £8.

Grade 4: 10.30 – 11.00

Grade 5: 11.00 – 11.30

Grade 6: 11.30 – 12.00

Progressive: 12.30 – 1.15
